The Bible Hymns: 65, 30, 83

Have mercy upon me, O God and uphold me with thy free spirit. Psalms 51

In the beginning God created the heaven and the earth. And God said, Let there be light: and there was light. And God said, Let us make man in our image. So God created man in his own image, in the image of God created he him; male and female created he them.
