Divine Science explains the abstract statement that there is one Mind by the following self-evident proposition: If God, or good, is real, then evil, the unlikeness of God, is unreal. And evil can only seem to be real by giving reality to the unreal. Page 470

The starting-point of divine Science is that God, Spirit, is All-in-all, and that there is no other might nor Mind,---that God is Love, and therefore He is divine Principle. To grasp the reality and order of being in its Science, you must begin by reckoning God, as the divine Principle of all that really is. All substance, intelligence, wisdom, being, immortality, cause, and effect belong to God. Divine metaphysics, as revealed to spiritual understanding, shows clearly that all is Mind, and that Mind is God, omnipotence, omnipresence, omniscience,--that is, all power, all presence, all Science. Hence all is in reality the manifestation of Mind. Page 275

The universe, like man, is to be interpreted by Science from its divine Principle, God, and then it can be understood; but when explained on the basis of physical sense and represented as subject to growth, maturity, and decay, the universe like, man, is, and must continue to be, an enigma.
